- for employees agreements have been drawn up for the purchase of "green" products and services

 we live. These products include latest generation domestic electrical appliances, LED bulbs, waste
 bins. Furthermore "Ambientiamo", the training platform for environmental issues, has been
 enriched with new modules and it can now be reached, with some examples, from the Internet

- customers will be made aware through messages on ATM, which promote the Online Reporting
 and Easy Fattura (Easy Invoice), tools designed for families, professionals and businesses that
 choose not to waste unnecessary paper and protect the environment.

Furthermore, on the Group Intranet and Internet sites a **Handbook** (Italian version), drawn up in collaboration with Legambiente, is provided. It lists "good behaviours" for both the workplace and home: the major changes are made only as a result of a radical change in mentality so apparently remote targets can only be achieved with the cumulative effect of individual behaviour.
