The awarded project regards the "Nearly 0 energy branch" in Marghera

On June 13, 2013, during the Green Globe Banking Conference held in Milan, the Green Globe Banking Award, Direct Impacts category, was given to Intesa Sanpaolo.

The award is the only Italian one who actively engages the banking and financial system and concerns the development of products, eco-efficient activities and investments for the protection and enhancement of "natural capital" of the territories in which banks operate.

Intesa Sanpaolo received the important award for the project "Nearly 0 energy branch" in Venezia Marghera.

The branch presents innovative solutions related to the reduction of energy consumption - such as low transmittance windows, thermal insulation, environmentally friendly furniture, as well as energy self-production from renewable sources through a photovoltaic system and a geothermal heat pump.

Thanks to the innovative solutions, the branch has reduced energy consumption by 65%, thus obtaining the energy class A certification.
